

FY19 Staffing

What UCMC's Flexible Approach Delivers for Nurses and Patients

Responding flexibly to actual patient needs has resulted in UCMC's Med/Surg units being staffed ahead of the union's one-size-fits-all California-style staffing ratios. Over the last three fiscal years, our Med/Surg units on average staffed 3.62 patients per nurse, consistently delivering better average staffing than the fixed 4 patients-per-nurse model proposed by the NNOC/NU. Average staffing can vary by unit. Here is 4 Central's staffing ratio below.

4 Central

In FY19, the average staffing ratio was **3.45** patients-per-nurse.
